1. LAUNCHING M-VIEW MOBILE

From the Shortcut bar:

- Click on the m-View icon



From the Menu folder:

- Click on the m-View icon



2. CONFIGURING M-VIEW MOBILE

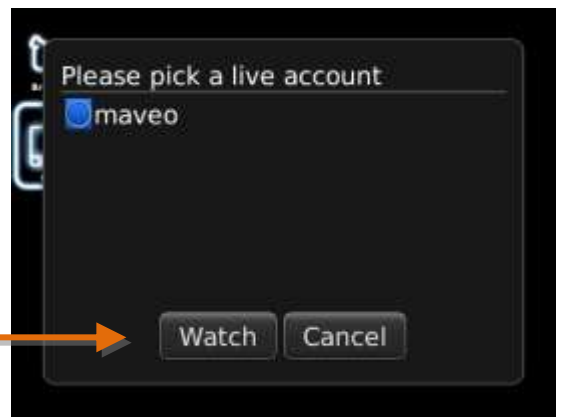
- Select **Menu button -> Settings**
- Select and enter the following details:

 Port: _____
 Web Server: _____
 APN: _____
 APN Username: _____

*** NB: Case sensitive so be sure to enter the capitals correctly**

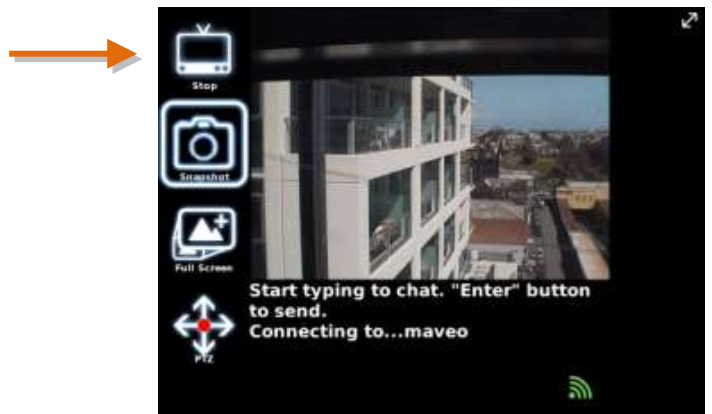


3. VIEWING LIVE VIDEO

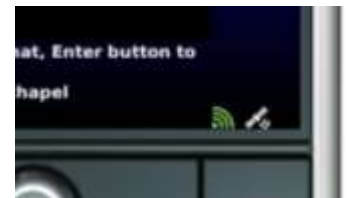
- Select the **“Watch”** Icon
- Select from the list of live accounts.
- Click **“Watch”**



- You will now be able to view the broadcast
- To end your viewing of the Broadcast scroll to highlight **“Stop”** icon at the top left



- Signal strength is indicated by the green radio icon at the bottom right of the screen
- If GPS is turned on at the broadcaster, the satellite icon will display to the right of the signal strength icon.



4. SENDING & VIEWING SNAPSHOTS

To take a snapshot during a live video broadcast, either

- Scroll to the "snapshot" icon to the left of the video and click

OR

- Select **Menu Button -> Take Photo**

Snapshots appear to the right hand side of the video.

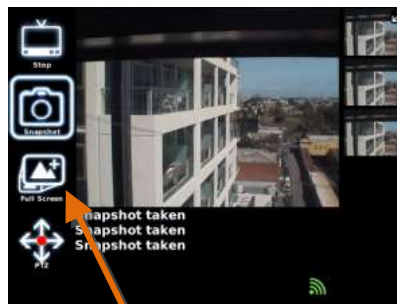
To view a snapshot:

- Scroll to a snapshot to the right of the video and click
- Click again to return to live video.




5. FULL SCREEN

- To view the video in fullscreen mode, scroll to the "full screen" icon to the left of the video and click
- Press the return key to return to normal mode.



6. PAN TILT ZOOM

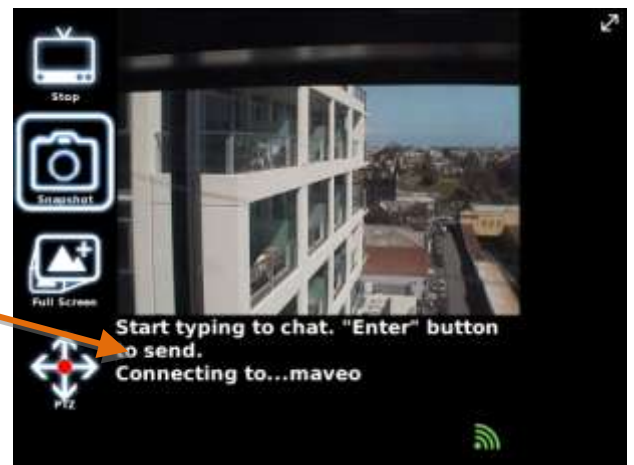
- The PTZ control is the bottom left icon. Scroll down until it is highlighted then click to activate the PTZ control.
- You will now be in Pan/Tilt mode. Use the ball control to move the camera. *Note: this will react fairly slowly in comparison to the Web Console control, so be patient.*
- Click again to toggle to Zoom mode. Use the ball control (move your thumb up and down to zoom in and out.)
- Clicking again will toggle back to Pan/Tilt mode.
- To exit PTZ mode click the return button. 



7. USING CHATBACK

Chat messages are displayed in the Chat area of the software

- To send Chat from the broadcaster to viewers start typing, click the enter button to send



8. BROADCASTING LIVE VIDEO

- Select **Broadcast icon**
- Select if you would like to send sms alerts to your contacts
- Select your contacts to send alerts to, then click "Accept"



- Upon successful connection, the live video is displayed in the centre of the screen

9. SENDING SNAPSHOTS

During a live video broadcast

- Click the "Snapshot" icon



10. ENDING A BROADCAST AND EXITING M-VIEW

- Click the **Stop icon** to stop the video broadcast
- Click the return button to exit the m-View application
