1. GETTING READY

A) Check if the phone is on:

- press the Unlock button 1
- The phone will “wake up” if it is on

B) Phone is On?

- Unlock the phone:
 1. Press “Menu” (Unlock Button 1)
 2. Press * (Unlock Button 2)

Phone is Off?

- If the phone is off press and hold down the power button until you feel the device vibrate.
- Enter the 4 digit PIN code if required



2. LAUNCHING M-VIEW MOBILE

From the Shortcut bar:

- Click on the **m-View** icon



From the Installations folder:

- Select Menu
- Select Installations
- Select m-View icon



3. CONFIGURING M-VIEW MOBILE

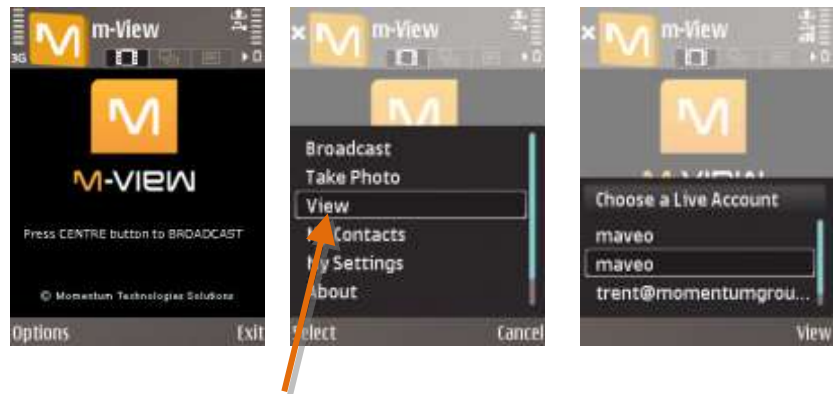
- Select **Options** -> **My Settings**
- Select and enter the following details:

Video Profile: _____
Private Broadcast: _____
GPS Location Posting: _____
Media Server: _____
Media Server Port: _____
Web Server: _____

*** NB: Case sensitive so be sure to enter the capitals correctly**

4. VIEWING LIVE VIDEO

- Select "Options" -> "View"
- Select from the list of live accounts.
- Click "View"



- You will now be able to view the broadcast
- To end your viewing of the Broadcast Select "Options" -> "Stop Viewing"



5. PAN TILT ZOOM

- The PTZ control is activated by keys on the keypad.
- 2 = up
- 8 = down
- 4 = left
- 6 = right
- * = zoom in
- # = zoom out

Note: this will react fairly slowly in comparison to the Web Console control, so be patient.



6. BROADCASTING LIVE VIDEO

- Click the **Centre Button**
OR

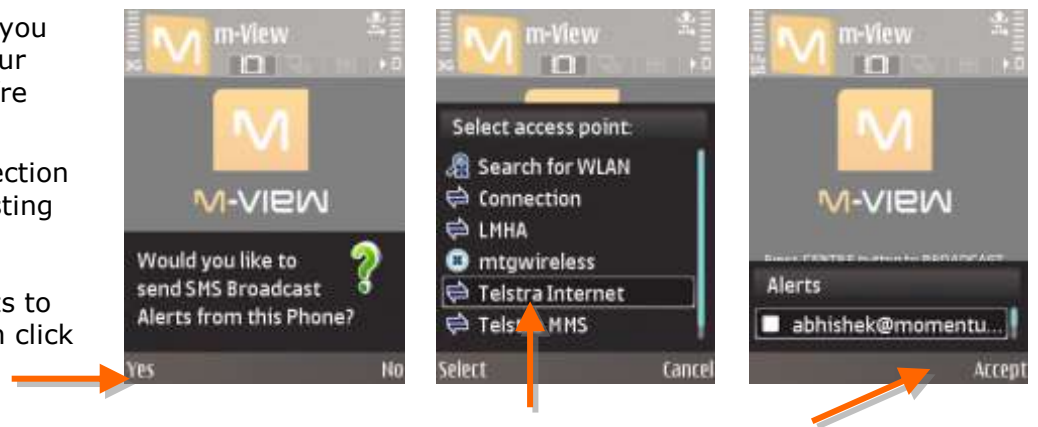


- Select **Options** -> **Broadcast**

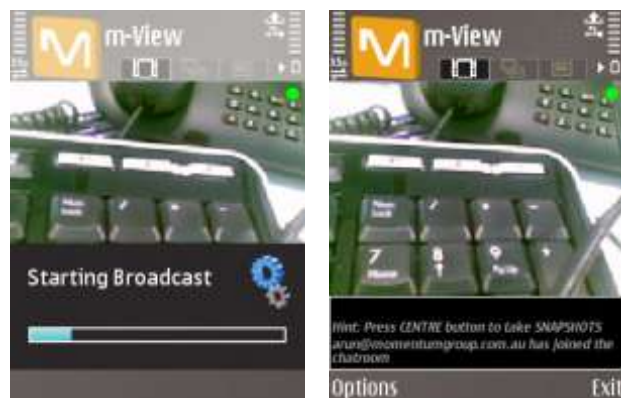


- Send SMS alerts if you would like to let your contacts know you're broadcasting
- Highlight the connection to use for broadcasting
- Select your contacts to send alerts to, then click "Accept"

Telstra Internet



- Upon successful connection, the live video is displayed in the centre of the screen



7. SENDING & VIEWING SNAPSHOTS

To take a snapshot during a live video broadcast, either

- Click the centre button

OR

- Select **Options** -> **Take Snapshot**

Snapshots appear to the right hand side of the video.



To view a snapshot:

- Click the right hand side of the centre button (this will take you to the snapshot tab)
- Select the image and click the centre button.

Click the left hand side of the centre button to take you back to the live video tab.



8. USING CHATBACK

Chat messages are displayed in the Chat area. To send Chat from the mobile broadcast to viewers:

- click Options -> chat -> Send chat message.
- Type your message and hit send





9. MAKING A PHONE CALL WHILE STREAMING

With m-View broadcasting:

- Press & hold the "home" key
- Select "Standby mode" by scrolling down the list and then clicking the "centre button"

This will run m-View in the background while you instigate the phone call.

- Make a phone call as normal
- While the call is still active, swap back to m-View:
 - Press and hold the "home" key
 - Select "m-View"
- Continue to broadcast as normal while you are on the phone call

NOTE: If you do swap out of m-View while streaming, it will continue to run in the background. Be sure to double check that you don't leave m-View open after you finish a call.



10. POOR INTERNET CONNECTION

- If you are in an area where there is a poor 3G connection, the green dot in the top right-hand corner will turn red
 - You will be prompted to drop your bandwidth.
 - **Click on Yes.**
- Poor internet coverage areas may be:**
- inside a heavily bricked or metal building/room
(try to stay close to the window, or go outside if possible)
 - rural areas
 - peak times of day (e.g. around 3-4pm when school gets out)

11. ENDING A BROADCAST AND EXITING M-VIEW

- Click **Exit**
(stops the broadcast and exits m-View)
- OR
- Click **Options** -> **Stop Broadcast**
(stops the broadcast and keeps the m-View application open).
